Huntsville is home to the U.S. Space & Rocket Center, where you can see real rockets, space suits, and even try astronaut training activities.

Alabama has beautiful nature parks like DeSoto State Park and Little River Canyon—great places for waterfall hikes, cabin stays, and campfire nights.


Alabama's state bird is the Yellowhammer, a bright woodpecker. It's also where the state's nickname comes from!

#### Alabama Road Trip Hangman How to Play:


- 1. **Pick A Word:** One player (the host) thinks of a word, and draws blank spaces for each letter ( ).
- 2. Guess Letters: Other players take turns guessing letters one by one.
- 3. **Fill or Draw:** If the letter is in the word, the host writes it in the blanks. If not, the host draws part of the "hangman" (e.g., head, body, arms, legs).
- 4. **Keep Guessing:** Keep guessing until you figure out the word or the drawing is finished.
- 5. **Win or Try Again:** If you guess the word before the drawing is done, you win! If not, no worries just pick a new word and keep the road trip fun going!

It's where Rosa Parks made history by refusing to give up her bus seat.




#### Pecan Pie Is a Big Deal Here

The pecan is the state nut—find it in pies, candies, and even trail mix!




#### Alabama Has Real Covered Bridges

Huntsville is where the rockets that launched astronauts to the moon were built—visit the U.S. Space & Rocket Center to see a real Saturn V!




