What Makes Alabama Famous: Top 10



Huntsville is home to the U.S. Space & Rocket Center, where you can see real rockets, space suits, and even try astronaut training activities.

Alabama takes college football very seriously! Whether you're cheering "Roll Tide" (University of Alabama) or "War Eagle" (Auburn University), it's a major part of state pride.



Alabama has beautiful nature parks like DeSoto State Park and Little River Canyon—great places for waterfall hikes, cabin stays, and campfire nights.

With more than 300 types of freshwater fish and diverse ecosystems, Alabama is perfect for spotting turtles, butterflies, and even alligators on nature trails

The state insect is the colorful monarch butterfly. If you're driving through Alabama in spring or fall, keep your eyes out—they're migrating!



Way back in 1836, Alabama became the first U.S. state to officially celebrate Christmas. That means Alabama's been jingling bells longer than anyone else!



Alabama is famous for pecan pie, fried green tomatoes, BBQ, and blackberry cobbler. It's a sweet and savory road trip for your taste buds.

This town is famous for its legendary recording studios. Famous singers like Aretha Franklin, Elton John, and The Rolling Stones recorded hit songs here.

Montgomery was where Rosa Parks refused to give up her bus seat. Kids can visit the Rosa Parks Museum and learn about brave people who changed history.

Alabama's state bird is the Yellowhammer, a bright woodpecker. It's also where the state's nickname comes from!

Alabama Road Trip Hangman

How to Play:

1. **Pick A Word:** One player (the host) thinks of a word, and draws blank spaces for each letter (_ _ _ _).
2. **Guess Letters:** Other players take turns guessing letters one by one.
3. **Fill or Draw:** If the letter is in the word, the host writes it in the blanks. If not, the host draws part of the “hangman” (e.g., head, body, arms, legs).
4. **Keep Guessing:** Keep guessing until you figure out the word or the drawing is finished.
5. **Win or Try Again:** If you guess the word before the drawing is done, you win! If not, no worries – just pick a new word and keep the road trip fun going!

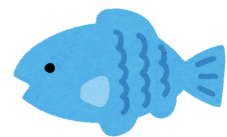
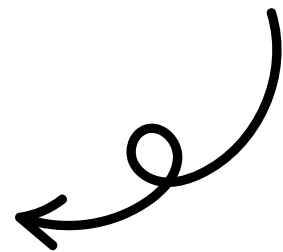
Alabama Has Real Covered Bridges

You can visit historic covered bridges in Blount County—great for family photos and learning local history.



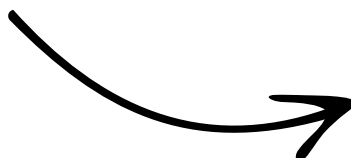
Little River Canyon Is One of the Deepest in the Southeast

Huntsville is where the rockets that launched astronauts to the moon were built—visit the U.S. Space & Rocket Center to see a real Saturn V!

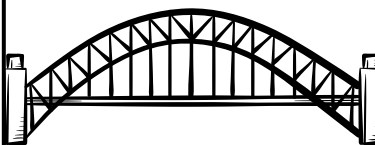
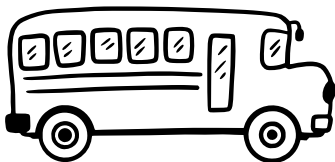
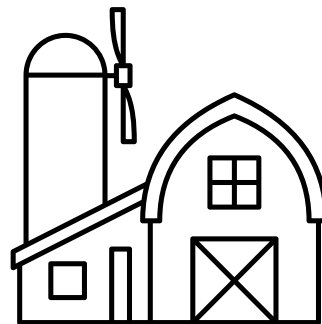
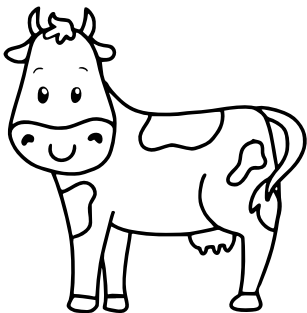
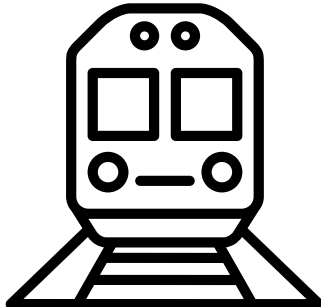
