I Spy: Georgia Road Trip



How to Play:


- 1. **Pick A Word:** One player (the host) thinks of a Georgia-themed word, and draws blank spaces for each letter (_ _ _ _ _).
- 2. Guess Letters: Other players take turns guessing letters one by one.
- 3. **Fill or Draw:** If the letter is in the word, the host writes it in the blanks. If not, the host draws part of the "hangman" (e.g., head, body, arms, legs).
- 4. **Keep Guessing:** Keep guessing until you figure out the word or the drawing is finished.
- 5. **Win or Try Again:** If you guess the word before the drawing is done, you win! If not, no worries just pick a new word and keep the road trip fun going!


