# Hawaii Road Trip Hangman

## How to Play:

1. **Pick A Word:** One player (the host) thinks of a Hawaii-themed word, and draws blank spaces for each letter ( \_ \_ \_ \_ ).
2. **Guess Letters:** Other players take turns guessing letters one by one.
3. **Fill or Draw:** If the letter is in the word, the host writes it in the blanks. If not, the host draws part of the "hangman" (e.g., head, body, arms, legs).
4. **Keep Guessing:** Keep guessing until you figure out the word or the drawing is finished.
5. **Win or Try Again:** If you guess the word before the drawing is done, you win! If not, no worries – just pick a new word and keep the road trip fun going!

Hawaii is the only U.S. state made up entirely of islands! There are 137 islands in total, but only 7 are inhabited.

It's home to the world's most active volcano. Kilauea, on the Big Island, has been erupting on and off for decades!

You can see rainbows almost every day. Hawaii is nicknamed the "Rainbow State" because of its frequent rainbows.

Hawaii is the only state that grows coffee. The Kona region on the Big Island is famous for its coffee beans.

The Hawaiian alphabet only has 12 letters. It includes 5 vowels (A, E, I, O, U) and 7 consonants (H, K, L, M, N, P, W).

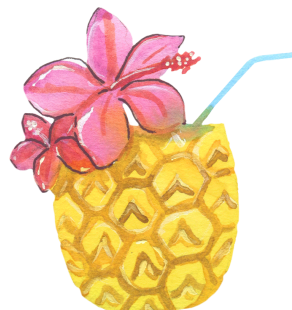
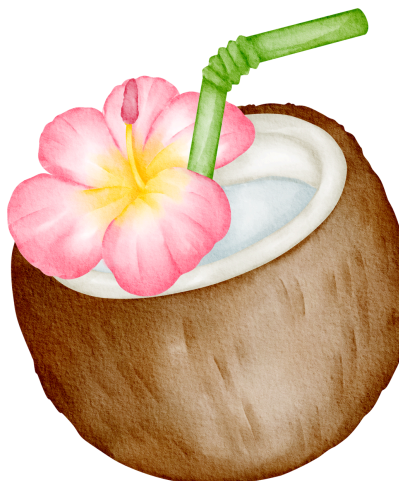
Hawaii has black, green, and even red sand beaches. These colorful beaches are made from volcanic materials.
