New Jersey Road Trip Hangman

How to Play:

1. **Pick A Word:** One player (the host) thinks of a New Jersey-themed word, and draws blank spaces for each letter (_ _ _ _).
2. **Guess Letters:** Other players take turns guessing letters one by one.
3. **Fill or Draw:** If the letter is in the word, the host writes it in the blanks. If not, the host draws part of the "hangman" (e.g., head, body, arms, legs).
4. **Keep Guessing:** Keep guessing until you figure out the word or the drawing is finished.
5. **Win or Try Again:** If you guess the word before the drawing is done, you win! If not, no worries – just pick a new word and keep the road trip fun going!

This chewy candy was invented in Atlantic City and is a must-try treat at the Jersey Shore.

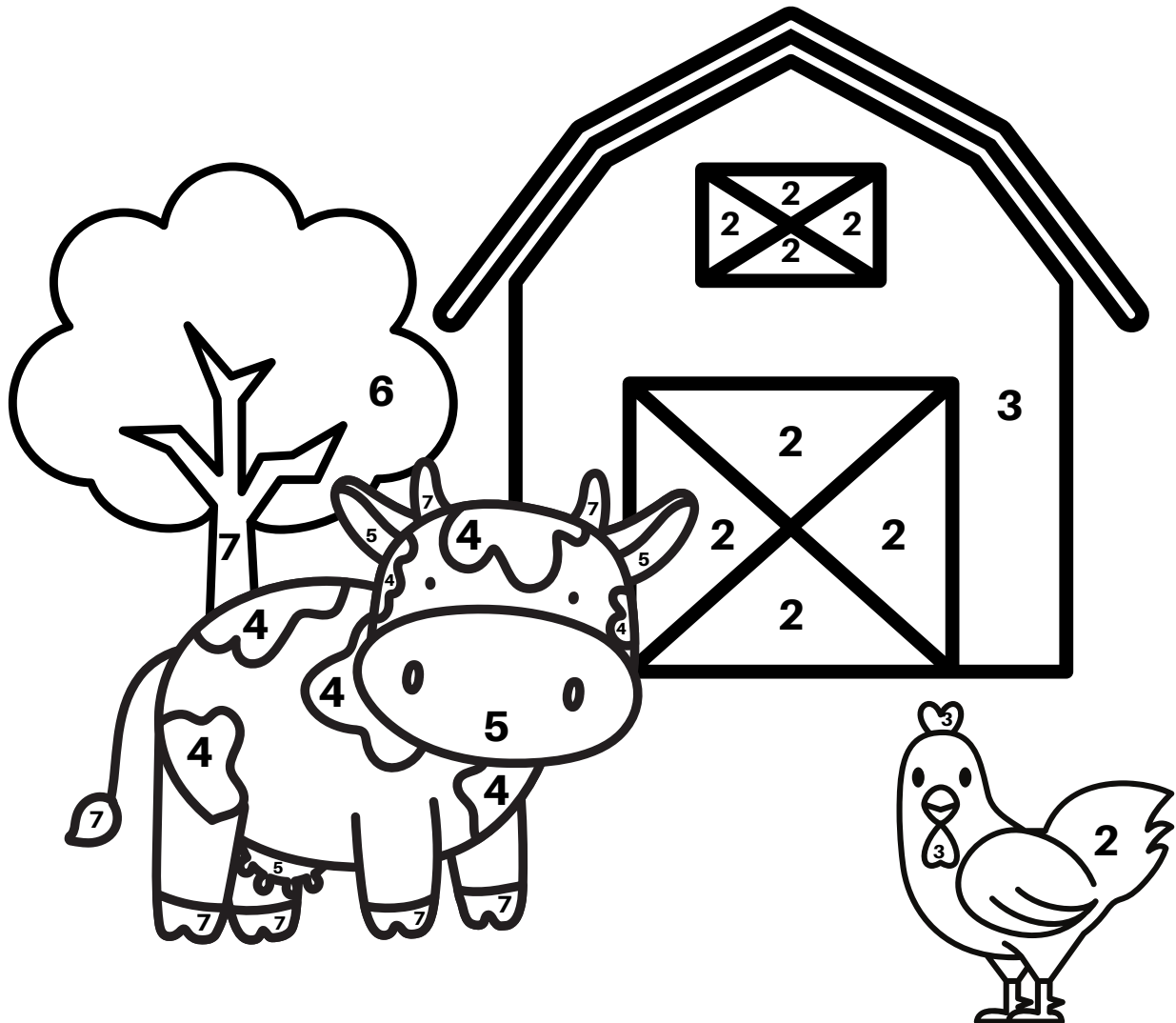
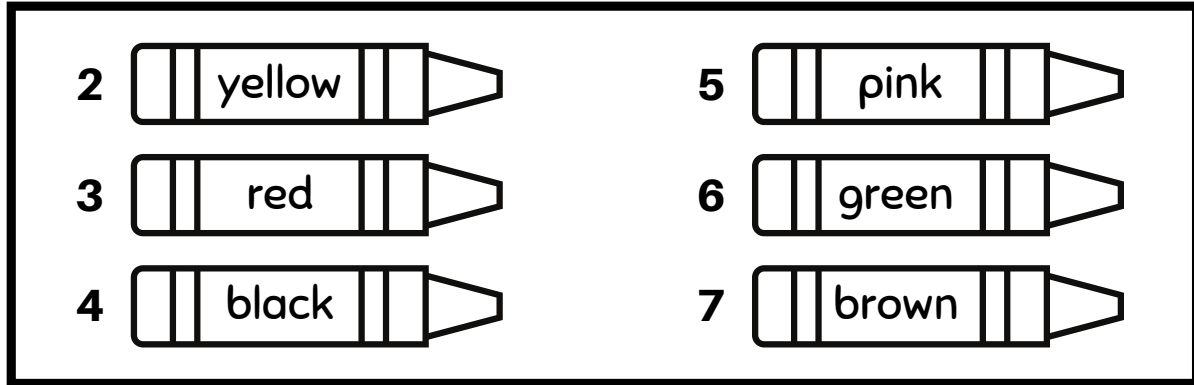
Thomas Edison, who invented the light bulb, had his famous laboratory in Menlo Park, New Jersey.

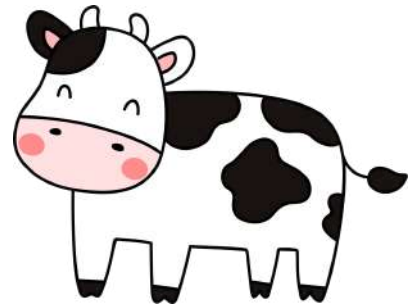
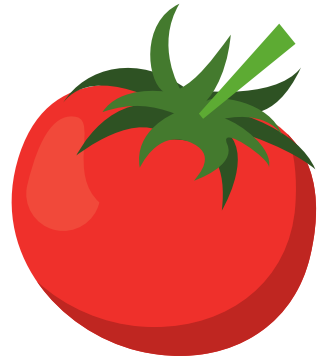
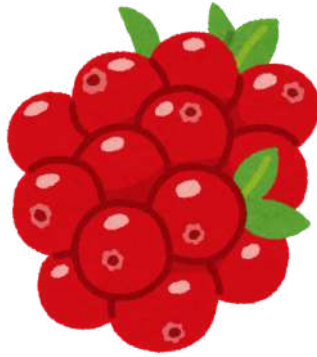
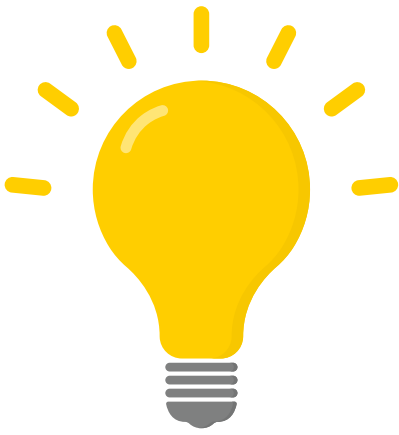
New Jersey grows tons of tomatoes, blueberries, and cranberries, making it a top farming state despite its small size.



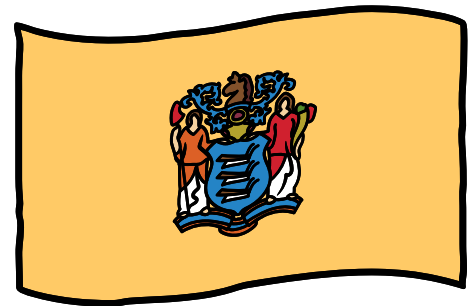
