






SUMMER RIDDLES

Read each riddle, then cut out the pictures of the summer items below and paste them into the correct box.




I'm fiery and golden, a star in the sky, What am I, that warms as I fly?

Get To Know Brown Bears



Person: teacher, sister, superhero Place: beach, mountain, treehouse Thing: backpack, ice cream, robot

What's a Verb?

Verbs are action words. They're what you do! Think of: Run, jump, swim, eat, dance

What's an Adjective?

Adjectives describe things. They tell you what something looks, feels, or sounds like. For example:

Silly, shiny, smelly, gigantic, colorful

What's an Adverb?

Adverbs tell how something is done. They usually end in "-ly." For example: Quickly, happily, loudly, neatly
