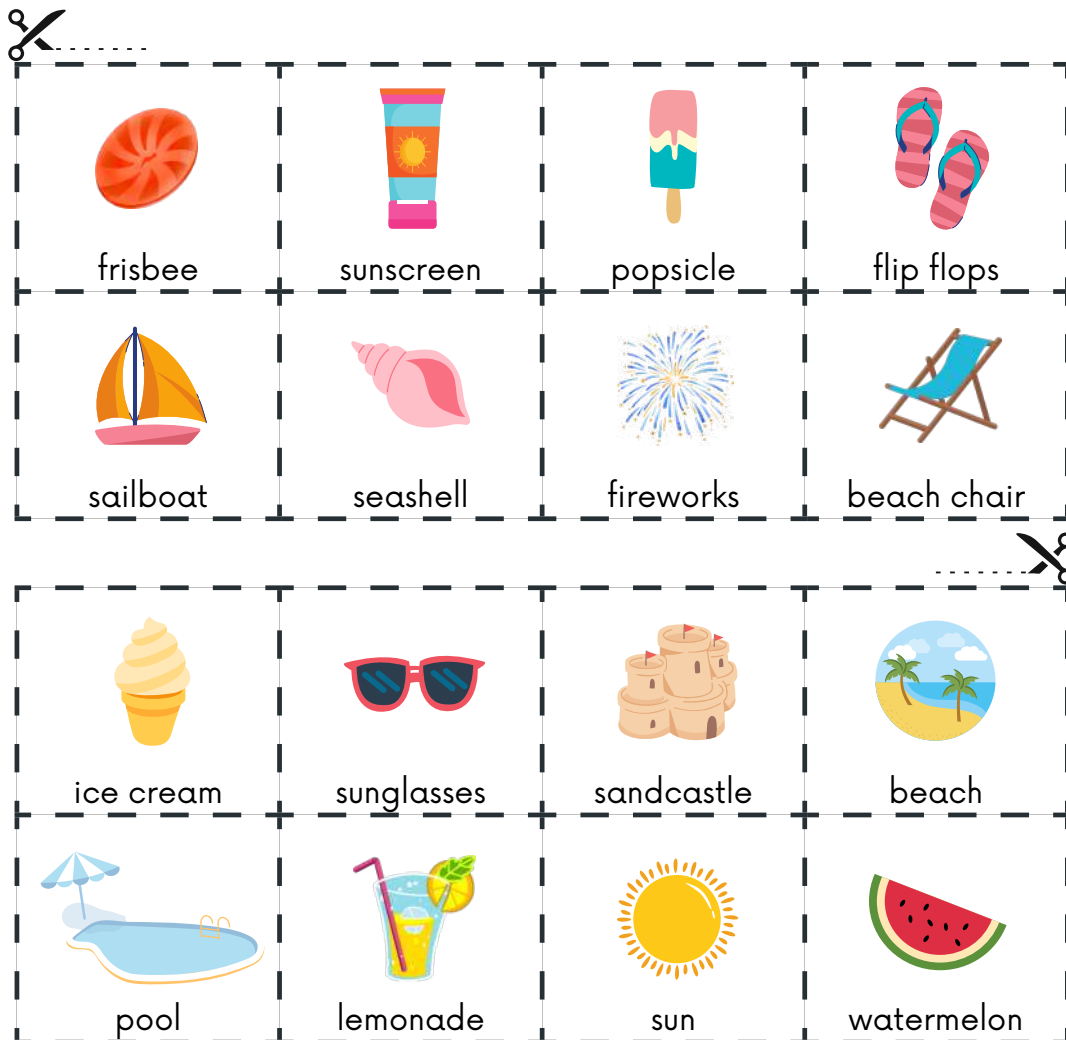
	I soar through the air when given a throw, Round and flat, with a spin I go. I'm a game, a toy, a catch in the park, What am I, that flies till I arc?

Get To Know Brown Bears

Brown bears are amazing animals! They are really big and super fuzzy. Most brown bears have thick brown fur, but sometimes their fur can be a little lighter or darker, kind of like shades of chocolate! These bears have round ears, a big snout, and really sharp claws that they use for digging and catching food.

What's an Adjective?

For example:

Silly, shiny, smelly, gigantic, colorful

What's an Adverb?

Adverbs tell how something is done. They usually end in "-ly." For example:

Quickly, happily, loudly, neatly
