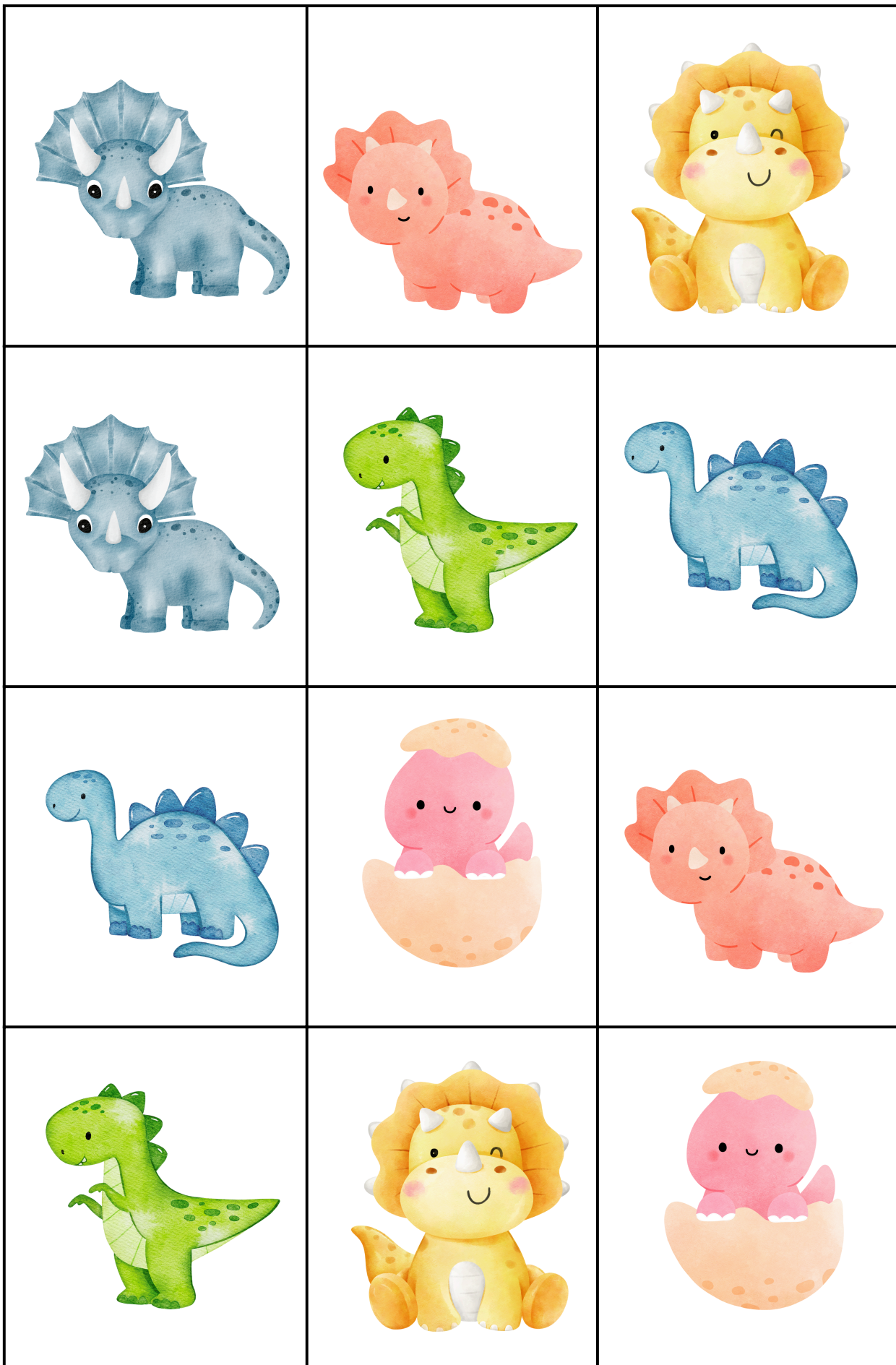


Dinosaur Memory Game

What Makes Arkansas Famous: Top 10

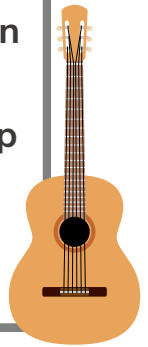


Arkansas has the only public diamond mine in the U.S. Visitors can dig for real diamonds at Crater of Diamonds State Park!

Famous country singer Johnny Cash was born in Kingsland, Arkansas. He grew up singing on the farm before becoming a music legend.



Hot Springs National Park has steaming natural water that's over 4,000 years old! People have been bathing there for healing and relaxation for centuries.
