Classic seaside fun with a family-friendly boardwalk, arcades, beach shops, and fresh funnel cakes.



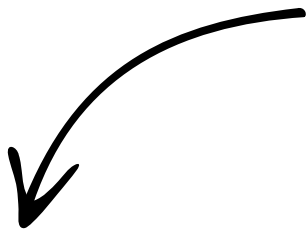
Brandywine Zoo (Wilmington)

A small but charming zoo nestled in a park along the Brandywine River.



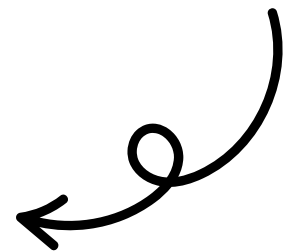
Winterthur Museum, Garden & Library (near Wilmington)

Home of the **Blue Crab**

Delaware's coastal waters are full of blue crabs, and many local restaurants serve them steamed with Old Bay seasoning.

Second Smallest State

Only Rhode Island is smaller! But Delaware still packs in beaches, history, and lots of fun activities.

Delaware Is the **First State!**

Delaware was the first state to ratify the U.S. Constitution on December 7, 1787—earning its nickname, The First State.

No Sales Tax!

Delaware has no state sales tax, which makes shopping in towns like Rehoboth Beach extra fun for parents and kids.

Delaware Grows a Lot of Chickens!

It's one of the top chicken-farming states in the U.S.—you'll see lots of chicken farms driving through the countryside.

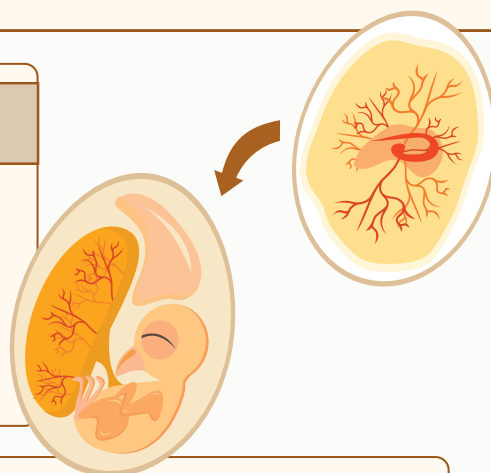
State Bird Is the Blue Hen

The Blue Hen chicken became a symbol during the Revolutionary War because of its fierce spirit.

CHICKEN LIFE CYCLE

STAGE 1 - EGG

A chicken's life begins inside an egg. Hens lay the eggs and keep them warm through incubation, either naturally or in an incubator.



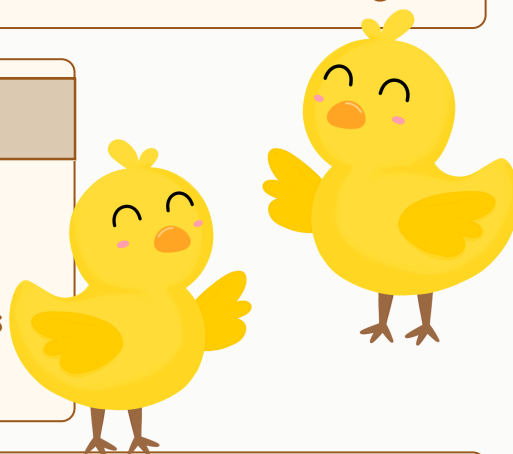
STAGE 2 - CHICK

When the egg hatches, a fluffy chick emerges with soft down feathers. It needs warmth, food, and care to grow quickly and prepare for the next stage.



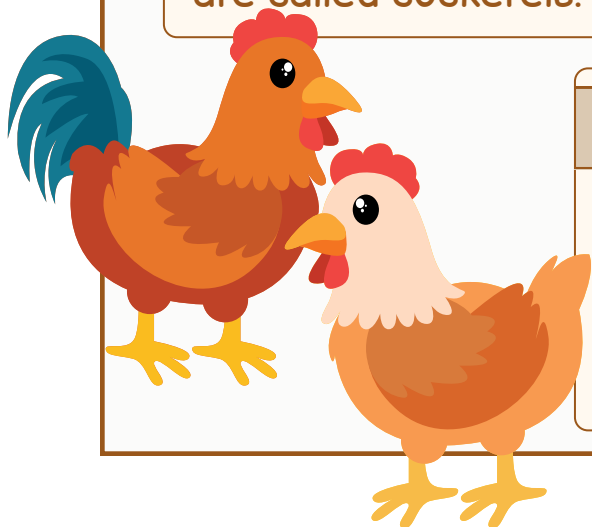
STAGE 3 - JUVENILE CHICKEN

As chicks grow, they develop feathers and start to look like adult chickens. Females are called pullets, and males are called cockerels.



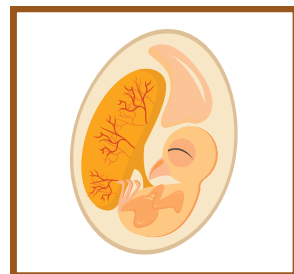
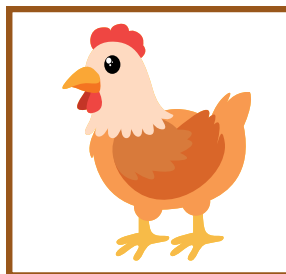
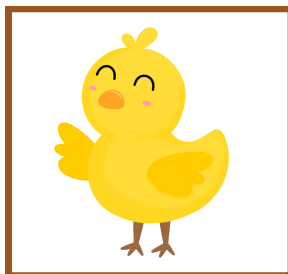
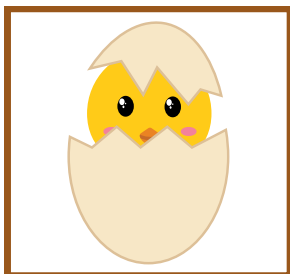
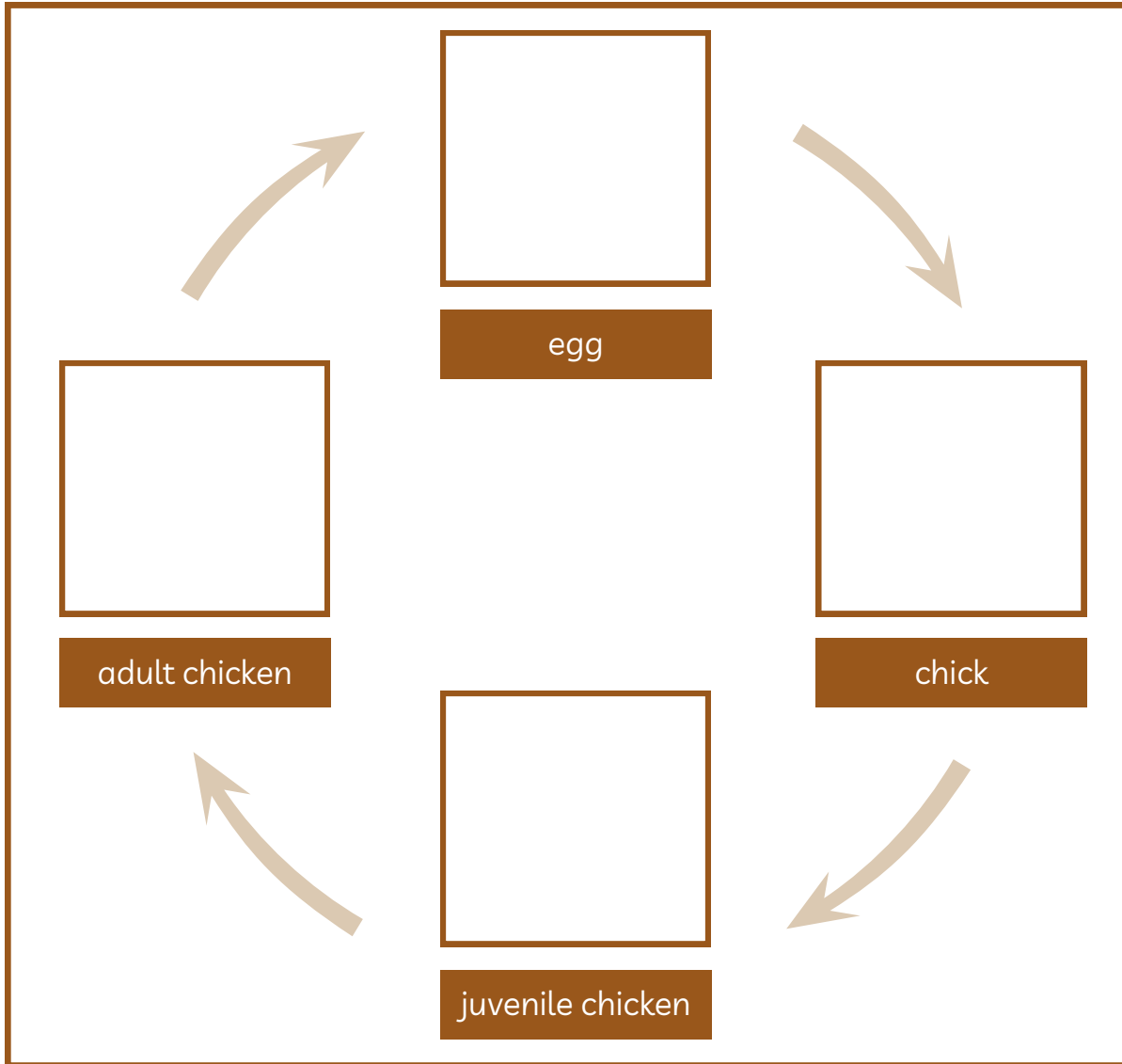
STAGE 4 - ADULT CHICKEN

When fully grown, chickens become adults. Hens lay eggs to start the cycle again, and roosters protect the flock. They have the skills they need to thrive.



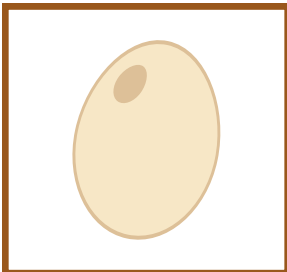
LIFE CYCLE OF A CHICKEN
