What Makes Idaho Famous: Top 10



Idaho grows more potatoes than any other state. You'll see fields full of them and even visit the Idaho Potato Museum in Blackfoot!

The beautiful capitol building in Boise is made of Idaho marble, and you can take free tours inside.

Shoshone Falls in Twin Falls is actually taller than Niagara Falls and absolutely beautiful!

Idaho is home to parts of the Rocky Mountains, Sawtooth Mountains, and gorgeous lakes like Lake Coeur d'Alene—perfect for hiking, boating, and swimming.

Craters of the Moon National Monument. This weird and wonderful place is filled with ancient lava flows that make you feel like you're walking on another planet!

The World Center for Birds of Prey

Located in Boise, this center helps protect endangered birds like eagles, hawks, falcons, and owls. Kids can see raptors up close!



Idaho was part of the famous Lewis and Clark Expedition, and you can still visit some of the places they explored.

Idaho has some of the best rivers for whitewater rafting in the U.S., including the Salmon River, known as "The River of No Return."

Idaho has over 70 kinds of gemstones, including star garnets, which are only found in Idaho and India!

There are more than 130 natural hot springs in Idaho, many perfect for relaxing while surrounded by nature.



Road Trip Hangman

How to Play:

1. **Pick A Word:** One player (the host) thinks of a word, and draws blank spaces for each letter (_ _ _ _).
2. **Guess Letters:** Other players take turns guessing letters one by one.
3. **Fill or Draw:** If the letter is in the word, the host writes it in the blanks. If not, the host draws part of the "hangman" (e.g., head, body, arms, legs).
4. **Keep Guessing:** Keep guessing until you figure out the word or the drawing is finished.
5. **Win or Try Again:** If you guess the word before the drawing is done, you win! If not, no worries – just pick a new word and keep the road trip fun going!

Walk on ancient lava fields that look like you're on the moon! Kids can explore lava tubes and learn about volcanoes.



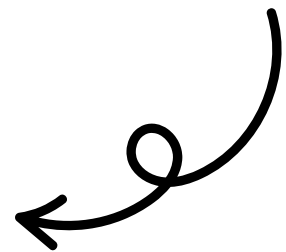
Tour the Idaho Potato Museum
